

# The Journey of Jesus to the Cross

## A look at Jesus' travels in **Mark 7 – 14**

Use the following travel journal with a map showing Israel during the time of Jesus Christ. The maps in the back of your Bible should include one showing the land of Israel during the time Jesus was on the earth. Trace his travels from Tyre to Jerusalem as recorded in Mark chapters seven through fourteen.

### Chapter Seven

- At the end of chapter seven Jesus comes out of Tyre and goes to the Sea of Galilee.

### Chapter Eight

- Near the Sea of Galilee, He feeds the four thousand.
  - The Sea of Galilee was sometimes referred to as the Sea of Tiberias.
- He then gets in a boat and sails to the district of Dalmanuthea.
  - Dalmanuthea was on the west side of the Sea of Galilee near Magdala.
- The Pharisees in that district harass Him for a sign.
- He then leaves Dalmanuthea and sails back to the other side of the Sea.
- They went on from there to Bethsaida. In Bethsaida Jesus heals a blind man.
- From there they went to the villages of Caesarea Philippi. Here Jesus asks the disciples who the people say He is and He asks them who they say He is.

### Chapter Nine

- Six days later Jesus takes Peter, James, and John up to the top of a nearby mountain and He is transfigured before them.
- After coming down from the mountain they leave and go throughout Galilee, eventually ending up in Capernaum.

### Chapter Ten

- Leaving Capernaum, they went to the region of Judea beyond the Jordan river.

- Following the Jordan river they eventually come to a place where they can cross over to Jericho.
- As He was leaving Jericho, He healed Bartimaeus from blindness.

## Chapter Eleven

- On the way to Jerusalem, they stop in Bethphage near Bethany.
- Jesus asks the disciples to find a donkey.
- Jesus rides into Jerusalem on the donkey as the people cry “Hosanna blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord” and lay down their robes for Him to ride across.
- He enters Jerusalem and goes into the Temple where He overturns the tables of the money lenders.
- In the evening, He returns to Bethany.
- In the morning, He goes back into Jerusalem.

## Chapter Twelve

- All events in this chapter occur in Jerusalem.

## Chapter Thirteen

- Jesus leaves Jerusalem for the day and sits on the Mount of Olives with His disciples.

## Chapter Fourteen

- He is in Bethany at the home of Simon the leper.
- He leaves Bethany and goes to Jerusalem.
- He celebrates the Passover in Jerusalem.
- After the Passover Jesus and the disciples leave the upper room and go to the Mount of Olives.
- They end up in the Garden of Gethsemane, which means olive press, and Jesus asks the disciples to watch while He goes off to pray.
- Judas brings officers of the Sanhedrin into the Garden where he betrays Jesus.
- Jesus is arrested and taken away to Jerusalem to be tried before the High Priest.
