We primarily serve unreached international students in our city. Afghanistan, Bangladesh, India, Japan, China, Mongolia and Kazakhstan are a few of the countries our students come from. Our home group Bible studies average 100+ students. Additionally, our activities with students include welcome picnics and boating parties that pave the way for gospel conversations and discipleship. We have a ministry called "Bikes to Bibles" transporting Bibles to Afghan refugees, who are invited to attend our Bible discovery groups.
